**ONCE AGAIN – Entries can be made directly online at the fair website 24/7. A maximum of five (5) entries per student are allowed.** An entry blank is also enclosed with this booklet. You may make copies for those who can not enter online. (Each student MUST have their OWN entry blank)

For the purpose of identifying pieces, **please label ALL artwork on the back with the student's name, grade, and their school's name.**

School Art will be judged by the Danish Judging System. This means that every entry will earn a ribbon - Blue, Red, White, or Pink, and a cash premium.

## OZAUKEE COUNTY FAIR – EDUCATIONAL DIVISION SCHOOL ART

**Open to All Schools in Ozaukee County and All Students attending school or homeschooled in Ozaukee County – Kindergarten thru Grade 8, and DIVISION T for Grades 9-12 ONLY.**

### PREPARING ENTRIES

1. Each student exhibitor must submit their own entry with a maximum of five (5) pieces of work per student.

Entries can be made directly online at

[www.ozaukeecountyfair.com](http://www.ozaukeecountyfair.com).

If this is not possible, use a paper entry blank.

2. Exhibitor may make only 1 entry per Class in a Division. If there is a duplicate class number on an entry blank, the articles will be eliminated.
3. All entries are due on or before May 1<sup>st</sup> online or to the County Fair Showworks Coordinator (address on entry blank)
4. Use the numbers listed below to indicate Department and student grade level.

**Grades 9–12 May enter ONLY in DIVISION T

**DIVISION A – CRAYON – Use crayons only!**

Done on flat surface.

Prepare piece for transport and exhibit.

**DIVISION I – MIXED MEDIA** – Using at least two media, for example: paint and crayon. Done on flat surface.

**DIVISION J – COLLAGE** – Done on flat surface.

**Class Numbers:**

- 01 Mosaic – Using textured items such as seeds, nuts, stones and/or tiles.
- 02 Textured materials – cloth, yarn, string, etc.
- 03 Collection of pictures – magazine or newspaper.
- 04 Any other collage – NOT LISTED

**DIVISION K – PRINT MAKING** –

Not penmanship. Done on flat surface.

Attach note on back as to what technique was used.

- 05 Printing done with a stencil
- 06 Relief printing
- 07 Printing done with any other object – Note on back what object was used.

**DIVISION M – PHOTOGRAPHY** – Prints must be 5” x 7” or they will be disqualified. All photos must be mounted.

Label work where necessary.

**DIVISION Q – CERAMICS** – Pieces must have been fired at least once.

(fired once then painted, not fired again)

**DIVISION R – SCULPTING**

**DIVISION T – OPEN ONLY TO GRADES 9-12**  
**Grades K - 8 enter Division N (NOT Division T)**  
**Grades 9-12 may NOT enter any other Division.**

**Class Number:**

- 01 Poster promoting the Ozaukee County Fair, not to exceed 11” x 17”.

Posters will be judged and then displayed at various locations throughout Ozaukee County. (Posters will not be returned, but may be eligible to be used on the cover of another year’s Premium Book.)

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Entry items must be brought to the Youth Building at the Ozaukee County Fairgrounds on Wednesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> between 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. No late items will be accepted.
2. All work must be done during the current school year at a school within Ozaukee Co.
3. All entries must be labeled on the back with the student's name, grade, **and the school name**.
4. Entry tags will be distributed at the fairgrounds on Wednesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
5. All paintings, drawings & photos must be matted and/or mounted for display.\* Do NOT staple.
6. Entry items must be picked up at the fairgrounds on Sunday, August 1<sup>st</sup> between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.
7. Teacher, please try to limit 'like' entries from a classroom. This eliminates the possibility of classroom competition.
8. All entries will be on display at the Fairgrounds from Wednesday, July 28<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 noon through Sunday, August 1<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 p.m.
9. Premium money will not be awarded for entries that are removed without having been checked-out with personnel on duty at release time.
10. Unclaimed entries may be picked-up ONLY on Monday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. in the 4-H Youth Building at the Fairgrounds. They will not be available after that date and time.

### **DATES FROM ABOVE TO REMEMBER**

- May 1<sup>st</sup>** – Completed entry blanks due.  
**June 2<sup>nd</sup>** – 9 a.m.-7 p.m. deliver all artwork to the Fairgrounds.  
**June 3<sup>rd</sup>** – 8 a.m. – Open Judging, continues for most of the day.  
**July 28<sup>th</sup>** – **Aug. 1<sup>st</sup>**-Artwork on display at Fair.  
**August 1<sup>st</sup>** – 8 p.m.-9 p.m. - pick up artwork from the display building.

### **DEFINITIONS OF WORDS AS USED IN THE PREMIUM LIST**

- BOOKLET** - This is the child's own work – drawing, writing stories or whatever else goes toward the make up of the booklet.
- CERAMIC** - Object made of clay that is either functional or decorative.
- FIGURE** - Picture of a person including body.
- CHART** - Shows listing of things related to a subject.
- CREATIVE** – A product produced by thought, imagination, and originality of a child, not copied. Invented by the person doing the work.
- MATTED** - Having a border around a picture between the picture and frame or serving as a frame.
- MOUNTED** – Having something behind the item being displayed to make it sturdy for handling.
- ORIGINAL** – Own work, not copied from another source or from a pattern.
- PORTRAIT** - Picture of person from the shoulders up with emphasis on the face.
- POSTER** – A poster is to convey an idea at a glance. Usually contains a slogan such as "Stop Fires". Poster illustrates the slogan or thought.
- UNIT** - One piece of work, but could have several parts which go together to make up one piece of work.
