## **Dos and Don'ts While in Your Crown and Sash**

Always remember that everything you do or say reflects on the Ozaukee County Fair. Be polite, cooperative, helpful and pleasant at all times, even when you think you may be out of the public eye.

Keep in mind these suggestions for proper and professional behavior as you perform your duties as the Ozaukee County Fairest of the Fair.

- Wear both your crown and sash for all official appearances.
- Take off your crown and sash when the appearance is over and you are on your own time.
- Wear suitable clothing appropriate for the function.
- Keep jewelry simple. Have jewelry accent your crown, not take away from it.
- Wear your hair in a professional manner at all times.
- Wear sensible shoes for the function.
- Know where you are to be and what you will do.
- Be enthusiastic and proud of your position.
- Greet people with a smile and a firm handshake.
- Address individuals by name, showing proper respect (or familiarity, if appropriate), and always maintain eye contact.
- Keep visits with friends and family to a minimum at appearances.
- Avoid inside jokes and derogatory comments.
- Use good judgment when responding to any request.
- Always discuss any questions or concerns with Fairest Coordinator.
